

Practice steps:

- 1. Theme in A minor with right hand in the soprano range
- 2. Theme in E minor with the left hand in the bass range
- 3. Theme in E minor with the right hand in the soprano range
- 4. Theme in A minor with the left hand in the bass range
- 5. The last two notes of the Theme as the downward sequence leading to the key of C major
- 6. Theme in C major with right hand in the soprano range
- 7. Theme in G major with the left hand in the bass range
- 8. Theme in G major with the right hand in the soprano range
- 9. Theme in C major with the left hand in the bass range
- 10. The last two notes of the Theme as the downward sequence leading to the key of D minor (with 1 flat)
- 11. Theme in D minor with right hand in the soprano range
- 12. Theme in F major with the left hand in the bass range
- 13. Theme in F major with the right hand in the soprano range
- 14. Theme in D minor with the left hand in the bass range
- 15. The last two notes of the Theme as the downward sequence leading to the key of A minor (with no accidentals)

Inverted Theme



- 16. Inverted Theme in A minor with right hand in the soprano range (start with the 1st scale degree)
- 17. Inverted Theme in E minor with the left hand in the bass range (start with the 1st scale degree)
- 18. Inverted Theme in E minor with the right hand in the soprano range (start with the 1st scale degree)
- 19. Inverted Theme in A minor with the left hand in the bass range (start with the 1st scale degree)

Theme with the counterpoint note against note of thirds and sixths in the second voice




- 20. Theme in A minor with right hand in the soprano range and counterpoint in left hand in the bass range
- 21. Theme in E minor with the left hand in the bass range and counterpoint with the right hand in the soprano range
- 22. Theme in E minor with the right hand in the soprano range and counterpoint with the left hand in the bass range
- 23. Theme in A minor with the left hand in the bass range and counterpoint in right hand in the soprano range
- 24. The last two notes of the Theme and counterpoint as the downward sequence leading to the key of C major
- 25. Theme in C major with right hand in the soprano range and counterpoint with the left hand in the bass range
- 26. Theme in G major with the left hand in the bass range and counterpoint with the right hand in the soprano range
- 27. Theme in G major with the right hand in the soprano range and counterpoint with the left hand in the bass range
- 28. Theme in C major with the left hand in the bass range and counterpoint with the right hand in the soprano range
- 29. The last two notes of the Theme and counterpoint as the downward sequence leading to the key of D minor (with 1 flat)
- 30. Theme in D minor with right hand in the soprano range and counterpoint with the left hand in the bass range
- 31. Theme in F major with the left hand in the bass range and counterpoint with the right hand in the soprano range
- 32. Theme in F major with the right hand in the soprano range and counterpoint with the left hand in the bass range
- 33. Theme in D minor with the left hand in the bass range and counterpoint with the right hand in the soprano range
- 34. The last two notes of the Theme with counterpoint as the downward sequence leading to the key of A minor (with no accidentals)

Inverted Theme with the inverted counterpoint note against note of thirds and sixths in the second voice

- 48. The last two notes of the Theme and counterpoint as the downward sequence leading to the key of D minor (with 1 flat)

- 49. Theme in D minor with right hand in the soprano range and counterpoint with the left hand in the bass range
- 50. Theme in F major with the left hand in the bass range and counterpoint with the right hand in the soprano range
- 51. Theme in F major with the right hand in the soprano range and counterpoint with the left hand in the bass range
- 52. Theme in D minor with the left hand in the bass range and counterpoint with the right hand in the soprano range
- 53. The last two notes of the Theme with counterpoint as the downward sequence leading to the key of A minor (with no accidentals)

Inverted Theme with the inverted counterpoint of mixed rhythms in the second voice A minor



- 54. Inverted Theme in A minor with the right hand in the soprano range and counterpoint with the left hand in the bass range
- 55. Inverted Theme in E minor with the left hand in the bass range and counterpoint with the right hand in the soprano range
- 56. Inverted Theme in E minor with the right hand in the soprano range and counterpoint with the left hand in the bass range
- 57. Inverted Theme in A minor with the left hand in the bass range and counterpoint with the right hand in the soprano range
- 58. Theme in eighth notes with the right hand in the soprano range in the key of D minor while holding the note D in the bass with the left hand
- 59. Inverted Theme in eighth notes with the left hand in the bass range in the key of A minor while holding the note D in the soprano with the right hand

Repeat steps 39-59 until you can play them fluently.
